

## ADMINISTRATIVE DIRECTIVE NO. 08-81

Subject: Designation of the Chief of Public Safety

Pursuant to RPPL 1-25 Section 6(a), I hereby designate the Police Chief to allow “on duty” officers to possess a firearm while acting in an official capacity. Said permission is limited to time of routine assignment through the duration of each officers working hours.

Police Officers designated as “on duty” on a standby basis as key personnel may keep at hand their personal service weapon or weapons at home while not on routine shift as follows:
