

ADMINISTRATIVE DIRECTIVE NO. 27-86

Subject: Conservation of Power

WHEREAS, the Republic of Palau is experiencing major electrical generation problem due to. generator. breakdowns at Malakal Power Plant; and

WHEREAS, operating generators are running in their full capacity and are vulnerable to burn outs; and

WHEREAS, the amount of power generated at present is much less than the power demanded by the public; and

WHEREAS, twenty-four hour power could be had if certain measures of power conservation are observed;

NOW THEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested in me as the Vice President according to the laws and the Constitution of the Republic of Palau, it is hereby directed as follows:

1. All Ministers shall remind their Bureau Directors that:
 - a. All electrical fixtures, equipment, appliances and others that consume electrical power be turned off when not in use or no longer needed;
 - b. All equipment and appliances consuming power be cleaned, reconditioned, and retuned in order to prevent unnecessary waste of energy; and
 - c. All electrical fixtures, equipment, appliances and others that consume electrical power be turned off at nights and on weekends except inside and outside security lights.
 - d. Rooms be tightly sealed to maximize air conditioners efficiency.

This Administrative Directive shall take effect upon issuance and shall remain in effect until amended, repealed, or declared otherwise.
