

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 106
[repealed by Executive Order 114]
*Allowing New Hiring and Other
Personnel Exceptions to Executive Order No. 103
Based on Case-By-Case Approval by the President*

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 103 froze Executive Branch vacancies, forms of promotion, annual within grade increases, and new hiring because of the budget difficulties experienced during fiscal year 1991; and,

WHEREAS, Fiscal year 1992 begins October 1, 1991, pursuant to budget authority in RPPL 3-60; and,

WHEREAS, the freeze on hiring and other personnel moves affects the Republic's ability to serve public needs and fails to account for changes in the operation of public facilities, such as the termination of the contract for the operation of the Aimeliik power plant and the need for the Ministry of Resources and Development to operate the power plant without the assistance of a public contractor;

THEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested in me as President, it is hereby declared, proclaimed, and ordered as follows:

1. Paragraph 1 of Executive Order No. 103 is hereby amended to allow new hiring, the renewal of existing contracts, and the filling of vacancies in public agencies; provided, however, that before any such personnel action becomes effective, a request shall first be submitted to the Office of the President naming the position, the salary proposed, and the immediate need that the position be filled, and the President shall have approved such request in writing.

2. Paragraph 4 of Executive Order No. 103 is hereby rescinded and shall not apply to expenditures made in fiscal 1992 pursuant to RPPL 3-60.

3. In all other respects, Executive Order No. 103 remains in full force and effect.
