

**EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 112**

*To Amend Executive Order No. 108  
Extending the Deadline for Submission of  
Findings, Conclusions and Recommendations of  
The Task Force on the Future of MOC to July 30, 1992*

**WHEREAS**, Executive Order No. 108 mandated the Task Force on the Future of MOC to report its findings, conclusions and recommendations to the President of the Republic of Palau no later than April 30, 1992; and

**WHEREAS**, Treaty talks between the representative governments have not yet concluded; and

**WHEREAS**, the status of the Land Grant Program, a U.S. Federal program and an important component of the College of Micronesia unified system, has yet to be resolved and will be a subject of the next Treaty Talk in Washington, D.C. on May 25, 1992; and

**WHEREAS**, the COM Treaty is due to expire on September 30, 1992;

**NOW THEREFORE**, by virtue of the authority vested in me as the President of the Republic of Palau, it is hereby ordered that the deadline set forth in Executive Order No. 108 for the submission of findings, conclusions and recommendations of the Task Force on the Future of MOC be extended from April 30, 1992 to July 30, 1992.
