

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 114

Rescinding Executive Orders No. 103 and 106

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 103, issued June 21, 1991, froze Executive Branch vacancies, forms of promotion, annual within grade increases, and new hiring because of budget difficulties experienced by the Republic of Palau in fiscal 1991; and

WHEREAS, Executive Order No. 106, issued October 1, 1991, rescinded certain portions of Executive Order No. 103 for fiscal 1992 but left other sections in full force and effect; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the procedures dictated by Executive Orders No. 103 and 106 and other sound fiscal management techniques, the Republic of Palau will not overspend its budget. in fiscal 1992; and

WHEREAS, improvement in the fiscal performance of the Republic of Palau should mean that emergency spending restrictions such as are contained in Executive Orders No. 103 and 106 will not be required during fiscal 1993;

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested in me as President, it is hereby declared, proclaimed, and ordered that Executive Orders No. 103 and No. 106 are rescinded effective October 1, 1992.
