

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 167

*Establishing an Ad Hoc Committee
To Identify Possible Sites For a
Sanitation Facility in Aimeliik State*

WHEREAS existing sanitation facilities are approaching maximum use; and

WHEREAS demand for sanitation facilities shows no signs of abating; and

WHEREAS the Republic must prepare to establish new sanitation facilities in order to address anticipated overflow from existing installations;

NOW, THEREFORE, there is hereby established an Ad Hoc Committee to Identify Possible Sites for a Sanitation Facility in Aimeliik State having the characteristics and functions described below:

A. Committee Membership. The members of the Committee, which shall be chaired by the Minister of Resources and Development, are:

Mr. Masasinge Arurang, Manager of Capital Improvements Projects Office

B. Committee Responsibilities and Powers. The Committee shall have the following responsibilities and powers:

1. the Committee shall establish a timetable for their activities, agree upon site selection criteria, and attend to such other organizational and procedural matters as the Committee deems appropriate;

2. the members of the Committee shall meet as necessary to identify and rank, according to criteria established by the Committee as a whole, possible sites for a sanitation facility within the State of Aimeliik;

3. in ranking the possible sites, each member shall take such steps as are necessary to become thoroughly familiar with each site, including, but not limited to, personally visiting the site, reviewing geological descriptions of the site, and examining title records of the site;

4. no later than one month following issuance of this Order, the Committee shall

draft and submit to the President, the Council of Chiefs of the State of Aimeliik, and Governor Reklai of Aimeliik a report setting forth the criteria used in identifying and evaluating the potential sites for the location of the contemplated sanitation facility, identifying the possible sites for the location of the contemplated sanitation facility, ranking each identified site, and explaining the basis for each site's ranking;

5. in identifying the sites addressed by the report referred to in paragraph 4, supra, the Committee shall describe the site with sufficient detail to allow the recipients of the report to visit and examine the exact same area as is assessed in the report and shall specifically include the identity of the owner of the potential sanitation facility site; and

6. the Committee shall provide such additional information and/or gather such additional data gathering as any of the addressees of the report requests.
