

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 20

Amending Executive Order No. 9 by (a) Transferring women interests activities to Ministry of Social Services and (b) Deleting broadcasting functions from Ministry of State

WHEREAS, since the reorganization of the Executive Branch on September 29, 1982 by Executive Order No. 9, it has been determined by Ministers of State and Social Services that women interests can best be carried out and coordinate within the Ministry of Social Services; and

WHEREAS, since then the Palau National Communications Corporation (PNCC) has been established by RPPL No. 1-40 and has, since its creation, taken over the functions of the radio broadcasting facilities including the daily operation of WSZB; and

WHEREAS, it is now imperative that pertinent provisions of Executive Order No. 9 be modified so as to appropriately reflect the aforementioned; and

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested in me as the President by the Constitution, laws and executive orders of the Republic of Palau, it is hereby ordered that Executive Order No. 9, as amended, is further amended in the following particulars:

1. A new Paragraph (vi) is added to PART III, Section 3(a) Division of Cultural Affairs, to read as follows:

“(vi) Develop, perform and coordinate women interest activities, programs and projects.”

2. Deleted from PART IV, Section 2. Bureau of Domestic Affairs, is the following phrase:

“and for coordination of women interests activities, programs and projects in consultation with the Committee on Planning and Programming of Women Interest Activities.”

3. Deleted from PART IV, Section 2(a)(v) Division of Public Affairs, is the following phrase:

“and operate broadcasting facilities.”

This Executive Order takes effect immediately upon issuance and shall remain in effect until otherwise superseded by subsequent order, or rendered ineffective by force of law enacted by the Olbiil Era Kelulau.
