

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 68

To establish a Personnel and Management Advisory Committee which will review the current management structure, policies and procedures of the Executive Branch and recommend ways to assist government agencies in the management of personnel resources and improve the effectiveness of such agencies in providing services to the public.

WHEREAS, the effective management of personnel resources can lead to reductions in expenses, increased productivity and improved delivery of services to the public by government agencies; and

WHEREAS, there exists a need to review the current structure, policies and procedures of the Executive Branch of the National Government relative to the management of personnel resources and to consider possible changes and improvements that will increase the efficiency and effectiveness of government agencies in providing services to the public;

NOW, THEREFORE, there is hereby created the Personnel and Management Advisory Committee which shall review the current management structure, policies and procedures of the Executive Branch of the National Government and make written recommendations to the President of ways to improve efficiency, reduce costs and improve the delivery of services to the public by government agencies. The Personnel and Management Advisory Committee shall be comprised of individuals who will be appointed by the President to serve at his pleasure and who shall be report to the President their findings within sixty (60) days hereof. All heads of departments, bureaus and divisions and of attached agencies, boards and commissions are hereby directed to provide all reasonable cooperation to the Committee.
