

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 69

*To Create a Juvenile Justice and Delinquency
Prevention Advisory Body*

WHEREAS, The Republic of Palau, by transfer agreement executed pursuant to Section 105 (h) (2) of the Compact of Free Association Act of 1985 (U.S. P.L. 99-239), is the successor in interest to the Government of the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands with respect to administration of grants and programs available to the Republic as provided for by the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act of 1974, as amended (U.S. P.L. 93-415); and

WHEREAS, by Section 223 of the Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Act, in order to receive formula grants, the President of the Republic is required to provide for an advisory group to carry out certain functions and to participate in the development and review of the Republic's juvenile justice plan, now, therefore,

There is hereby created a Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention Advisory Body comprised of fifteen (15) members to be appointed from time to time by the President of the Republic in accordance with the provisions of Section 223 of the Act and for the purposes therein specified.

For purposes of administration, and until and unless other designation is made, the Advisory Body shall be attached to the Ministry of Justice.
