

EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 95

*Designating the Individuals to Manage Employment and Personnel Matters in Accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the Public Service System
Published by the National Civil Service Board.*

WHEREAS, RPPL 1-37 Provides for a system of appropriate management officials to oversee employment and personnel matters within the government of the Republic of Palau; and,

WHEREAS, Ministers to head several Ministries have not been appointed or confirmed and, from time to time, Ministries will be vacant because of resignation, death, illness, or for other cause;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, NGIRATKEL ETPISON, PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF PALAU, ORDER:

THAT, FOR THOSE MINISTRIES AS TO WHICH A MINISTER HAS BEEN APPOINTED AND CONFIRMED AND IS IN OFFICE, THE APPROPRIATE MANAGEMENT OFFICIAL AS DEFINED IN 33 PNC 102 SHALL BE THE MINISTER OF THE MINISTRY WITHIN WHICH THE AFFECTED EMPLOYEE WORKS, WITH ALL POWERS GRANTED BY TITLE 33 OF THE PALAU NATIONAL CODE, AND THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE SYSTEM PUBLISHED BY THE NATIONAL CIVIL SERVICE BOARD.

THAT, FOR THOSE MINISTRIES AS TO WHICH A MINISTER IS NOT IN OFFICE, THE APPROPRIATE MANAGEMENT OFFICIAL SHALL BE THE HEAD OF THE BUREAU WITHIN WHICH THE AFFECTED EMPLOYEE WORKS, WITH ALL POWERS GRANTED BY TITLE 33 OF THE PALAU NATIONAL CODE, AND THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE SYSTEM PUBLISHED BY THE NATIONAL CIVIL SERVICE BOARD.

IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 2.3 OF THE RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE PUBLIC SERVICE SYSTEM, A COPY OF THIS ORDER SHALL BE SUBMITTED TO THE CHAIRMAN OF THE NATIONAL CIVIL SERVICE BOARD, TO ALL MINISTERS AND BUREAU HEADS, AND POSTED TO PROVIDE NOTICE TO ALL EMPLOYEES.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, I have signed this Executive Order this 2nd day of November, 1990, at the State of Koror, Republic of Palau.
