

PRESIDENTIAL PROCLAMATION NO. 02-93

Establishing an Earth Day for the Republic of Palau

WHEREAS, April 23rd is internationally recognized by countries throughout the world as Earth Day to promote knowledge regarding the conservation of the earth's resources and the planetary environment; and

WHEREAS, it is everyone's responsibility as stewards of the earth and its environment to prevent excessive exploitation and depletion of our natural resources; and

WHEREAS, our island environment, both above and below the surface of the ocean, is particularly fragile and our livelihood depends on our environment; and

WHEREAS, sustainable development will assure healthy and improved lifestyles for Palauan citizens today and future generations tomorrow; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of Earth Day is to proclaim a day upon which we will remind ourselves of the importance of taking care of the earth, conserving our natural resources and natural beauty for posterity's sake; and

WHEREAS, Palau is presently the Number One (1) Underwater Wonder in the World and it is our duty to maintain it for future generations of Palauans and for the world; and

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested in me as President of the Republic of Palau and in the interest of conserving Palau's natural resources for future generations, I hereby declare and proclaim April 23rd of this year as Earth Day in the Republic of Palau.
