

## **Presidential Proclamation No. 03-38**

*Declaring April 22, 2003, "Earth Day: Water For Life"*

WHEREAS, April 22nd is internationally recognized throughout the world as Earth Day to promote understanding of the need to conserve the Earth's resources and planetary environment; and

WHEREAS, it is everyone's responsibility, as stewards of the Planet Earth and its environment, to prevent excessive exploitation and depletion of our natural resources; and

WHEREAS, our island environment is very fragile and our future livelihood dependent on its preservation; and

WHEREAS, sustainable development will help today's Palauans achieve their desired financial goals and lifestyles without jeopardizing future opportunities for tomorrow's generation of Palauans; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of Earth Day is to proclaim a day upon which we will remind ourselves of the importance of protecting the Earth and conserving our natural resources and natural beauty for the sake of future health and prosperity; and

WHEREAS, all Palauans are encouraged to take those personal and community actions necessary to enhance and preserve our natural environment;

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested in me as President of the Republic of Palau, and in the interest of conserving Palau's natural resources for future generations, I hereby proclaim April 22, 2003 as Earth Day in the Republic of Palau with activities which began on March 24 through April 22, 2003, coordinated by an organizing committee chaired by the Environmental Protection Protection Board (EQPB).

SO PROCLAIMED this 16<sup>th</sup> day of April 2003 at Koror State, Republic of Palau.
