

PRESIDENTIAL PROCLAMATION NO. 03-94

To Recognize and Honor Mr. August Remoket

WHEREAS, Mr. August Remoket is retiring from the Government of the Republic of Palau after 42 years of exceptional service;

WHEREAS, Mr. Remoket has given exemplary dedication to his job and to the people and the Government of Palau;

WHEREAS, Mr. Remoket's service in Palau's Bureau of Public Works, from the early days of the Trust Territory Government through to the present, has always been one of duty above and beyond his normal responsibilities;

WHEREAS, Mr. Remoket has been involved in and responsible for numerous important projects for the Government of Palau;

WHEREAS, Mr. Remoket received his first appointment as Acting Public Works Officer in 1968 and was the first Micronesian in the Trust Territory of the Pacific Islands to be appointed to this position. Mr. Remoket was appointed Acting District Director of Public Works in 1979 and was to eventually be assigned numerous times as Acting Director of Public Works before being permanently promoted to this position in April 1993;

WHEREAS, Mr. Remoket's career in government service has been typified by his willingness to undertake every job, no matter how difficult, with enthusiasm and intelligence. He is recognized for his ability to organize and complete all tasks without complaint; and

NOW, THEREFORE, by this Proclamation, we recognize and honor his daily example of honesty, hard work, dedication and cheerful attitude. Included in this recognition is a check for \$500 as a merit award, showing the Government's appreciation to Mr. Remoket's on the occasion of his retirement. The entire National Government wishes the best future prosperity and success to an outstanding civil servant--Mr. August Remoket.
