

## **PRESIDENTIAL PROCLAMATION NO. 03-97**

Regarding Untimely Death of Former Legislator Kioshi A. Anderson

WHEREAS, on June 22, 1997, the Honorable Kioshi A. Anderson, former Legislator, from the State of Ngaraard, was called to eternal rest; and

WHEREAS, in 1976 to 1979, Mr. Anderson was a member of the Sixth Palau District Legislature representing Ngaraard Municipality; and

WHEREAS, in 1982, Mr. Anderson was Acting Chief Madrengebuked then member of the First Ngaraard Olbetibel; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Anderson, at the time of his passing, was survived by his wife Akemi, his three (3) daughters and four (4) sons, among other relatives.

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested in me under the Constitution and laws of the Republic and by the provisions of 1 PNC 503 (c) and of Executive Order No. 24, I, Kuniwo Nakamura, President of the Republic of Palau, hereby proclaim that a state of national mourning exists throughout the Republic of Palau as a tribute to the late Kioshi A. Anderson and that, to properly observe the occasion of the death of this distinguished public servant, all flags regularly flown within the jurisdiction of Palau, and national flags of the Republic flown at the embassy and consulates of Palau in other countries, shall be hosted at half-mast for a period of five (5) days commencing on June 28 and ending on July 3, 1997.
