

PRESIDENTIAL PROCLAMATION NO. 10-34

Honoring the late Senator Adalbert “Ada” Eledui and Directing that Flags Be Flown at Half-Mast in his Memory

WHEREAS, the Honorable Adalbert “Ada” Eledui passed away on December 14, 2010 during the second year of his four-year term as Senator in the Eight Olbiil Era Kelulau; and

WHEREAS, the late Senator Adalbert Eledui after completing his elementary and high school education in Palau Joined the United States Army in 1975 after attending the University of Guam, and

WHEREAS, after retiring from the United States Army in 1992 as Sergeant Major, the late Adalbert Eledui returned home where he dedicated his efforts to the promotion of conservation programs and projects until he was elected to the Senate of the Eight Olbiil Era Kelulau on November 4, 2008;

WHEREAS, the death of the late Senator Eledui is a real loss not only to his family and clan but to the people of Palau;

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested in me under the Constitution and laws of the Republic of Palau, and by provision of 1 PNC 506©) and Executive Order No. 24, I, Johnson Toribiong, President of the Republic of Palau, hereby proclaim that as a display of respect, his country and his fellow citizens had for the late Senator Adalbert “Ada” Eledui, all flags regularly flown within the jurisdiction of Palau, and all flags of the Republic of Palau flown at the Embassies and Consulates of Palau in other countries, shall be hoisted at half-mast for a period of five days, commencing on January 3, 2011.
