

PRESIDENTIAL PROCLAMATION NO. 23-84

Re: Death of Delegate Tem Obakerbau

WHEREAS, in the early hours of Saturday, March 31, 1984, the late Delegate Tem Obakerbau of Aimeliik State to the House of Delegates, First Olbiil Era Kelulau, passed away; and

WHEREAS, the late Delegate Tem Obakerbau was a distinguished educator and a dedicated public servant not only of his native State of Aimeliik but also of the Republic of Palau as a member of the previous Palau District Legislatures; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate that the general public of Palau join the family and relatives of late Delegate Tem Obakerbau and his colleagues in the House of Delegates, in observing a period of mourning for his untimely death;

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 7 of the Constitution of the Republic of Palau and Public Law No. 7-6-2, I, Haruo I. Remeliik, President of the Republic of Palau, hereby proclaim a five-day period of mourning commencing on Monday, April 2 through Friday, April 6, 1984, as a tribute to the late Delegate Tem Obakerbau of Aimeliik State; and

BE IT FURTHER PROCLAIMED that all flags flown within the territorial jurisdiction of the Republic of Palau be flown at half-mast during the said period of mourning.
