

PRESIDENTIAL PROCLAMATION NO. 24-84

Re: Death of Honorable Minister David Ramarui

WHEREAS, in the late hours of Friday, April 6, 1984, the late honorable Minister David Ramarui of the Republic of Palau passed away; and

WHEREAS, the late Honorable Minister David Ramarui was a distinguished leader and a dedicated public servant not only of his native home land of the Republic of Palau, but also as a principle staff member of the High Commissioner for the entire Micronesia under the Trust Territory Administration; and

WHEREAS, it is appropriate that the general public of Palau join the family and relatives of late honorable Minister David Ramarui and his colleagues in government services in observing a period of mourning for his untimely death;

NOW, THEREFORE, by virtue of the authority vested in me by Section 7 of the Constitution of the Republic of Palau and Public Law No. 7-6-2, I, Haruo I. Remeliik, President of the Republic of Palau, hereby proclaim a five-day period of mourning commencing on Monday, April 9, through Friday, April 13, 1984, as a tribute of the late Honorable Minister David Ramarui;

BE IT FURTHER PROCLAIMED that all flags flown within the territorial jurisdiction of the Republic of Palau be flown at half-mast during the said period of mourning.
