

PRESIDENTIAL PROCLAMATION NO. 29-85

Declaring Wednesday, May 1, 1985 Law Day in Palau

WHEREAS, the stability and health of a nation depends upon respect for law; and

WHEREAS, the ability of the people of our nation to live and work together depends upon the value they place on the laws of the Republic of Palau; and

WHEREAS, the birth of our nation was founded in law, and our nation will be guided in the future by the law; and

WHEREAS, the people of the Republic of Palau are themselves the maker of the laws by which they live; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of our nation should learn of the role of the law in their lives, and how this is a nation of laws, and under law; and

WHEREAS, the first day of May has been declared Law Day in other lands, and the Republic of Palau recognizes the importance of law in the affairs of nations and their peoples;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Haruo I. Remeliik, President of the Republic of Palau, declare Wednesday, May 1, 1985, Law Day, to be observed with fitting ceremonies throughout the Republic.
