

PRESIDENTIAL PROCLAMATION NO. 30-85

Re: Death of Delegate Hank Takawo

WHEREAS, Delegate Hank Takawo of the State of Kayangel passed away on Saturday, April 20, 1985; and

WHEREAS, former Delegate Hank Takawo held many important public posts in Palau --- he represented Kayangel in the 1979 Palau Constitutional Convention, he was a senator representing the states of Ngarchelong and Kayangel in the First Olbiil Era Kelulau, and at the time of his untimely death, he was the Floor Leader of the House of Delegates in the Second Olbiil Era Kelulau; and

WHEREAS, the people of Kayangel and the Republic of Palau have lost an important public servant and will sorely miss the wise counsels of former Delegate Hank Takawo;

NOW THEREFORE I, Haruo I. Remeliik, President of the Republic of Palau hereby proclaim April 21st to April 26th, 1985 as a period of public mourning for the late Delegate Hank Takawo, and I further direct that all flags flying in the Republic of Palau shall be lowered to half-mast to mark this period of mourning for the late Delegate Takao.
