

## PRESIDENTIAL PROCLAMATION NO. 44-88

Declaring Thursday - April 7, 1988 World Health Day  
“World First No Tobacco Day”

WHEREAS, the health of a nation depends upon the health of its people; and

WHEREAS, April 7, 1988, has been designated by the United Nations World Health Organization as the “World Health Day”; and

WHEREAS, the people of Palau join the peoples of the World to observe and respect April 7, 1988, as “World Health Day”; and

WHEREAS, April 7, 1988, “World Health Day” has been specifically designated by United Nations World Health Organization as “World’s First No Tobacco Day”; and

WHEREAS, a Health Promotion Committee has been created to organize and promote activities of the “World’s First No Tobacco Day” program;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Lazarus E. Salii, President of the Republic of Palau, hereby proclaim and declare Thursday, April 7, 1988, as World Health Day wherein the people of this nation shall observe and respect all activities designed to promote health; and

BE IT FURTHER PROCLAIMED that a specific theme of this World Health Day is “World’s First No Tobacco Day”; and

BE IT FURTHER PROCLAIMED that no tobacco, raw or processed, be utilized in all the National Buildings and that all people are urged to observe and give respect to the day’s activities of the Health Promotion Committee;
