

PRESIDENTIAL PROCLAMATION NO. 49-89

Re: Death of Eusevio Termeteet

WHEREAS, Eusevio Termeteet passed away on May 23, 1989 after a long and unfortunate illness;

WHEREAS, Eusevio Termeteet's passing away is a great loss to the people and the Government of the Republic of Palau;

WHEREAS, he was a dedicated public servant who contributed in many ways for many years during the Japanese period and during the Trust Territory Administration in the areas of law enforcement, sports, and as a member of the earlier Olbiil Era Kelulau and the Council of Chiefs;

WHEREAS, Eusevio Termeteet had been one of the few Palauans whose understanding and wisdom on Palauan customs and social matters were sought by Government and community leaders, scholars and others from abroad and at home;

WHEREAS, the services he rendered and the dignity and honor he stood for was always of the highest order and should be appropriately recognized and respected;

NOW, THEREFORE, by the power vested in me as President under the Constitution and laws of Palau, I hereby proclaim May 23, 1989 to the day of interment as a period of public mourning for the late Eusevio Termeteet, and I further direct that all flags flying within the Republic of Palau and its offices abroad shall be lowered to half-mast to mark this period of mourning.
