

PRESIDENTIAL PROCLAMATION NO. 53-89

Re: Death of the Late Pablo Kyochi, Former Member of the First Olbiil Era Kelulau

WHEREAS, it is my sad duty to report that former Delegate Pablo Kyochi died on September 26, 1989; and

WHEREAS, Pablo Kyoshi rendered outstanding service to the people of Palau, first as a member of the Palau District Government and subsequently as Delegate to the First Olbiil Era Kelulau from the State of Hatohobei; and

WHEREAS, the citizens of our Republic will miss the leadership and example of former Delegate Pablo Kyoshi;

NOW, THEREFORE, as President of the Republic of Palau, I proclaim Wednesday, September 27, 1989, as a day of mourning for the passing away of the late Pablo Kyoshi;

I FURTHER PROCLAIM that all flags flown within the territory of the Republic of Palau be flown half-mast, pursuant to law, on Wednesday, September 27, 1989 to continue to and including Sunday, October 1, 1989, as a gesture of respect and mourning for Pablo Kyoshi.
