

AN ACT

To appropriate \$704,372.00 from the National Treasury of the Republic of Palau for the operation and contingent expenses of the Senate and the House of Delegates of the Olbiil Era Kelulau (National Congress) for the period from April 1, 1981 to September 30, 1981, and for other purposes.

THE PEOPLE OF PALAU REPRESENTED IN THE OLBIIL ERA KELULAU DO ENACT AS FOLLO

1 Section 1. The sum of \$368,694.00, or so much thereof as may be
2 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the National Treasury of the Republic
3 of Palau for the operation and contingent expenses of the Senate of the Olb
4 Era Kelulau for the period commencing April 1, 1981, through September 30,
5 1981.

6 The sum herein appropriated shall be apportioned in accordance with
7 the following schedule:

8	1. Compensation of Senators	\$136,000.00
9	2. Official Expenses	54,000.00
10	3. Personnel Benefits	4,354.00
11	4. Personnel & Temporary Hires	45,340.00
12	5. Representation	31,000.00
13	6. Standing/Joint Committee Exp.	35,000.00
14	7. Official Travel	40,000.00
15	8. Supplies, Equipment, Printing	
16	and Reproduction	13,000.00
17	9. Other Services	10,000.00
18	TOTAL	<u>\$368,694.00</u>

19 Should there remain any balance of the aforesaid sum of \$368,694.00
20 unexpended and not contracted or obligated for expenditure on September 30,
21 1981, such balance shall revert to the National Treasury of the Republic of
22 Palau.

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1 Section 2. The sum of \$335,678.00, or so much thereof as may be
2 necessary, is hereby appropriated from the National Treasury of the Republic
3 of Palau to defray the operational costs and contingent expenses of the House
4 of Delegates of the Olbiil Era Kelulau (National Congress) for the period
5 commencing April 1, 1981 through September 30, 1981.

6 The sum herein appropriated shall be apportioned according to the
7 following schedule:

8	1. Compensation of Delegates	\$121,000.00
9	2. Official Expenses	48,000.00
10	3. Personnel Benefits	3,234.00
11	4. Personnel & Temporary Hires	41,444.00
12	5. Representation	31,000.00
13	6. Standing/Joint Committee Exp.	30,000.00

17	9. Other Services	10,000.00

19 Should there remain any balance of the aforesaid sum of \$335,678.00
20 unexpended and not contracted or obligated for expenditure on September 30,
21 1981, such balance shall revert to the National Treasury of the Republic of
22 Palau.

23 Section 3. The sum allocated in Section 1 of this Act shall at all
24 times be subject to reallocation at the direction and upon authority of the
25 President of the Senate, provided such reallocation from one program item to
26 another does not exceed fifteen percent (15) of the total sum appropriated
27 for the particular program item from which the reallocation is made.

1 The sums respectively allocated for various purposes in Section 2 of
2 this Act shall at all times be subject to reallocation at the direction and
3 upon the authority of the Speaker of the House of Delegates, provided such
4 reallocation from one program item to another does not exceed fifteen percent
5 (15%) of the total sum appropriated for the particular program item from
6 which the reallocation is made.

7 Section 4. Administration and Expenditure of Funds. The sums
8 allocated in Section 1 and Section 2 of this Act shall be administered and
9 expended by the President of the Senate and Speaker of the House of Delegates
10 of the Olbiil Era Kelulau, respectively, for the purposes specified therein
11 PROVIDED, HOWEVER, the National Treasurer shall first make certification as to
12 the availability of funds after which each of the said presiding officers shall
13 authorize payments to be made.

14 Section 5. The presiding officers of the Senate and the House of
15 Delegates of the Olbiil Era Kelulau (National Congress) shall prepare and
16 submit to the public auditor a report on all the expenditures made pursuant
17 to Section 1 and Section 2 of this Act on or before December 30, 1981.

18 Section 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the
19 President of the Republic of Palau, or upon its becoming law without such
20 approval, and upon the expiration of such period as prescribed by law during
21 which the High Commissioner may suspend all or part of this Act.
