

AN ACT

To appropriate funds for the annual unified national budget for the Republic of Palau for fiscal year 1982, and for other purposes.

THE PEOPLE OF PALAU REPRESENTED IN THE OLBIIL ERA KELULAU DO ENACT AS FOLLOWS:

1 Section 1. The sum of \$10,321,000.00 is hereby appropriated
2 subject to quarterly allotments such that at no time may any
3 budget activity or department listed below expend or obligate
4 more than one-fourth of the total amount of its annual funds
5 appropriated, in any given quarter, from the Department of the
6 Interior federal grant funds, deposited in the National Treasury
7 of the Republic of Palau, for fiscal year 1982, said sum to be
8 apportioned to the budget activities or agencies listed below or
9 upon the organization of the executive branch under various
10 ministries and under the direction of the President of the
11 Republic of Palau, to the successors of said agencies, or budget
12 activities according to the following schedules:

4 Section 3. (a) The sum of \$1,604,000.00 is hereby appro-
5 priated from the National Treasury of the Republic of Palau as

28 authorizing and appropriating legislations duly enacted and
29 signed by the Chief Executive Officer of the State, and approved

3 measure enacted shall specify the amount and manner in which the
4 block grant funds shall be used, and a full accounting and report
5 of the same shall be submitted to the President of the Republic

7 Section 4. Effective Date. This Act shall take effect
8 upon its approval by the President of the Republic of Palau, or
9 upon its becoming law without such approval, except as otherwise
10 provided by law.
