

MEDICAL FEE SCHEDULE POLICY
MINISTRY OF HEALTH
REPUBLIC OF PALAU

THE FOLLOWING POLICY SHALL APPLY ALONG WITH THE 1995 MEDICAL FEE SCHEDULE AT THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND WILL BE EFFECTIVE ON THE 1ST OF OCTOBER 1997.

1. All Non-Citizens of Palau are to be charged the new Medical Fee Schedules:
 - a. All non-citizens of Palau are to be charged for all medical care received as specified in the 1995 Medical Fee Schedule manual.
 - b. Non-citizen residents who are to receive free medical care are as follows:
 - 1) Australian officials of the Patrol Boat Project as part of the Surveillance Cooperation agreement between the governments of the Republic of Palau and Australia. They are officials of the Australian government and their families (See list of names).
 - 2) JOCV Japanese volunteers (See list of names).
 - 3) Korean Doctor assignee and his family members (See list of names).
2. All Palauan citizens are to be charged the 1995 Sliding Fee Schedules, except as follows:
 - a. The following list of health services are to be free to Palauan citizen children/students (see the attached list of services).
3. Definitions and guidelines:
 - a. Non-citizens of Palau - all non-citizens of Palau, including residents and transiting tourists and others.
 - b. Palauan citizen children/ students - a person who is a child/student and whose natural parent is a citizen of the Republic of Palau (A non-citizen person adopted to Palauan parents is a non-citizen of Palau).
